



## Rules of conduct and activity for students

The activities of the Center for Simulation and Practical Abilities are hosted by Building 24, located in the campus of the University. Students must acknowledge and observe the following rules:

- It is recommended to arrive 10 to 15 before the activity is scheduled
- Clothing and footwear must be comfortable so as to not impede movement
- Hospital equipment (white lab coat or scrubs) and identification tags are mandatory
- All personal belongings must be deposited in the locker room during all activities
- Locker keys will not be removed from their respective doors
- Access in other areas than the ones designated for activities is strictly forbidden
- Mobile phones must be kept in silent mode
- No food or beverages are allowed in the simulation rooms
- During simulations, all indications of the teaching staff must be strictly observed, and any manoeuver or procedure not previously discussed with or presented by the attending staff is strictly forbidden
- Caution must be exerted when using simulators and task trainers, in order to prevent deterioration
- All activities taking place in the simulation rooms are audio and video monitored. Students must sign a multimedia recording agreement prior to engaging any activity in the Center. Any student who does not sign this agreement cannot take part in simulations
- Any problem will be brought to the attention of the teaching staff
- Smoking is prohibited in all areas of the Center
