- 4.2. The Doctoral School provides transparency of assessment and selection of candidates for admission to PhD places offered by PhD supervisors, and guarantees access to this information by publishing it on the internet site of UMF Tîrgu Mureş and by other means of communication.
- 4.3. The information about admission will be published on the website of U.M.F. Tîrgu Mureş: http://www.umftgm.ro/doctorat/admitere-la-doctorat.html

5. Field of application:

- **5.1.** The procedure applies to the annual admission process to University PhD studies from the Doctoral School of IOSUD UMF Tîrgu Mureş.
- **5.2**. The procedure applies to all the admission processes to University PhD studies.

8. Description of the Operating Procedure:

8.1. Overview

- 1.) PhD studies represent the third cycle of academic studies and allow acquisition of a qualification of level 8 of the European Qualifications Framework for lifelong learning (EQF/CEC) and the National Qualifications Framework. The admission to PhDPhD studies studies is based on a competition organised by the University of Medicine and Pharmacy of Tîrgu Mureş (UMF Tîrgu Mureş) through IOSUD of UMF Tîrgu Mureş. Registration for admission to PhD studies can be done, regardless of the domain in which the candidate has obtained the bachelor's and master's degree.
- **2.)** The PhD studies are organised within the accredited Doctoral School of UMF Tîrgu Mureş, operating within the institutional framework of IOSUD of UMF Tîrgu Mureş. The Doctoral School functions as a higher education institution accredited by the Ministry of National Education on the bases of the periodic assessment of its institutional ability to offer an integrated learning environment and advanced research of national/international level.
- **3.)** Are entitled to participate to the admission competition, university graduates of the 1st cycle of studies in the sectoral regulated field, with minimum 300 study credits with a graduation certificate, as well as a master degree or the equivalent of this, from the country or from abroad for other fields. Graduates of the long-term 1st cycle of studies with diplomas issued up to the graduation of the first class, organised in accordance with the law no. 288/2004 can participate only with the graduation certificate. According to the regulations regarding the study credits, the 300 study credits are formed out of the 1st cycle of studies program with 180 study credits and a 2 year master program with 120 study credits (two master programs of one year equal 60 study credits; in this case credits cannot be summed up).
- **4.)** The PhD studies are organised only in the full-time form, with funding from the state budget (subsidised through research grants) or with tuition fees. According to the law, a person can receive funding from the state budget just for one doctoral program.
- **5.)** When registering for the admission competition, the PhD candidate chooses a PhD supervisor from the supervisors of the University of Medicine and Pharmacy Tîrgu Mureş who offer PhD places for the admission competition. The candidates compete for a place at the respective supervisor. If successful, the PhD supervisor will coordinate the PhD studies of the respective candidate at the Doctoral School

where the PhD has tenure.

- **6.)** The Procedure for Admission to University PhD studies is the process of selecting candidates for each PhD vacant place that the PhD supervisors from the Doctoral School decide to propose. By Senate Decision no. 5 from 8.04.2016, it was approved, for each field, a full-time state budget place, without an admission exam for the valedictorians of UMF Tîrgu Mureş from the Medicine, Pharmacy and Dentistry programs from that academic year. If students admitted on places with tuition fee (maximum 4 by Administrative Board's Decision no. 29/04.09.2017) present proof of assuming a co-tutoring program with a foreign PhD supervisor and minimum a mobility during the PhD studies, their annual tuition fee is covered by the University.
- **7.)** Doctoral Schools provide transparency of selection and admission to PhD studies, of assessment criteria and solicited standards, as well as access to these information.
- **8.)** The selection of candidates is done by a unique admission committee, consisting of the president (Director of CSUD/CSD), 3 CSD members and the PhD supervisor. The secretaries of the admission committee will be nominated from UMF's PhD students. The secretaries of the committee and the secretaries of the Doctoral School provide only the administrative activity and work for the admission process to the PhD studies
- **9.)** The allocation of places is done distinctly and in proportion to the Medicine, Pharmacy and Dentistry programs, related to the proportion of PhD supervisors corresponding to their fields of competence or by Senate decisions regarding the allocation of budget places in the fields of Medicine, Dentistry and Pharmacy.
- **10.)** I.O.S.U.D. of U.M.F. Tîrgu Mureş specifies the necessary documents for the enrollment to the PhD admission competition, the list being displayed both at the I.O.S.U.D, as well as on the site UMF Tîrgu Mureş. The admission requirements, including the number of places available, must be made public every year, by the university, at least 6 months prior to the admission contest.
- **11.)** It is forbidden, under penalty of law, that the criteria for assessing and selecting the candidates promote any candidates for PhD studies.
- **12.)** Nationals of EU, EEA or Swiss Confederation have access to PhD studies in the same terms as specified by the normative acts for Romanian citizens, including the fees (admission fee, tuition fees and PhD thesis defence fee).
- **13.)** Citizens not belonging to EU, EEA or Swiss Confederation, graduates of master degrees or graduates with a bachelor's degree or equivalent of long-term studies (4, 5, 6 years) have access to PhD studies under the same conditions as those provided by the normative acts for Romanian citizens. Studies conducted by them outside Romania are recognised by the National Centre for Recognition and equivalence of diplomas department of the Ministry of National Education.

8.2. Methodology

8.2.1

- (1) The registration process for Romanian citizens and citizens of EU, EEA or Swiss Confederation regarding the participation to the admission competition organised for PhD studies is as follows:
- (2) The candidate consults the list of scientific supervisors in different doctoral fields displayed both at I.O.S.U.D. U.M.F. Tîrgu Mureş (according to **Annex 04** of this procedure updated for each academic year) and on the website http://www.umftgm.ro/doctorat/admitere-la-doctorat.html. He/She also consults with the scientific supervisor he has chosen, in order to establish the project theme and fills in **Annex 06** Model of research project, for the evaluation and ranking of candidates.

- (3) The candidate pays the admission fee according to the approved fees for the academic year. (**Annex 05**).
- (4) The name of the candidate, as well as the mention "PhD admission registration fee, University of Medicine and Pharmacy of Tîrgu Mureş" will be mentioned on the receipt. The receipt will be attached to the registration dossier submitted to I.O.S.U.D. of U.M.F. din Tîrgu Mureş (Main building, second floor, room 236).
- (5) During the approved and announced registration period, the candidate submits at I.O.S.U.D. of U.M.F.Tîrgu Mureş, 38 Gheorghe Marinescu Street, second floor, room. 236, the documents mentioned in **Annex 01**:
 - a) standard registration form (Annex 02 and Annex 03);
 - b) Photocopies of: (accompanied by the original documents for compliance):
 - -Identity card;
 - -Birth certificate:
 - -Marriage certificate (if applicable) or name change certificate;
 - Baccalaureate diploma or equivalent;
 - Diploma of higher education (bachelor or equivalent) including the transcript of academic records;
 - Master degree (if applicable), certification/degree and transcript of academic records, Medical-Pharmaceutical Research Master Program.;
 - c) Curriculum vitae (Europass):
 - personal information;
 - work experience;
 - scientific activity indicating the areas of interest;
 - d) Certificate of employee of UMF Tîrgu Mureş (where applicable).
 - e) Evaluation record of scientific activity of the candidate (Annex 08):
 - I –works published separately: *In extenso* (scientific journals: ISI with or without impact factor, BDI/B+CNCSIS listed in: Medline/MD Consult, PubMed, Index Copernicus, Web of Science Clarivate Analytics, EBSCO, EMBASE, ScienceDirect (Scopus), ProQuest, SpringerLink, ERIH, CEEOL, DOAJ, Biosis, International Pharmaceutical Abstracts);
 - In extenso (scientific journals B, proceedings);
- In summary (congresses, conferences, symposia published in the supplements of some ISSN journals or in abstracts volumes with ISBNs);
 - II monographs (courses and practical work):
 - sole author/first author (publishing house with ISBN, mentioned in Cataloguing in Publication- CIP);
 - co-author (publishing house with ISBN);
 - f) Certificate of language competency (obtained from the Department of Modern Languages of UMF Tîrgu Mures) or a valid certificate of language competency with international recognition such as Cambridge, TOEFL, DALF, Goethe, PROFEX, TESPIS etc.
 - g) Model of research project in proposed theme (Annex 06)
 - h) Certificate of internal activities according to UMFTGM-REG-19 art.12 (where applicable);
 - i) Receipt proving payment of the admission fee;
 - j) Cardboard dossier.

for PhD studies, is regulated by the Order of Minister of National Education.

(2) Regarding admission to all university courses taught in Romanian, all foreigners are required to submit a certificate of language competency for Romanian issued by institutions authorized by the Ministry of Education, according to the approved methodology in force regarding the general organization and running of the admission to Bachelor's degree, master's and doctoral cycles for academic year 2017-2018.

8.2.3.

- (1) Regardless of the field, the competition for PhD admission consists of one examination, an interview to present the research project, on an accepted theme, agreed upon with the PhD supervisor, (Annex 06) as well as the evaluation of the scientific performance.
- (2) The admission to PhD studies will be preceded by an eliminatory language competency test to prove the mastering of an international language proposed by the applicant. The competency test is taken at the Department of Modern Languages, of UMF Tîrgu Mureş. If the candidate has a valid internationally recognised language certificate (Cambridge, TOEFL, Dalf, Goethe, PROFEX, TESPIS etc.), the competency test is not necessary. The test consists of a written test (listening comprehension, summary of a medical article, medical lexical exercises) and it will be completed with a grade of pass/fail.
- (3) The order of the budget places is established based on the final grade obtained by the candidate and based on the option selected on the standard registration form (for example, the candidates who have selected only the tuition fee places, cannot be enrolled on a budget place and vice versa). The candidates who have opted for budget places or for tuition fee places, will be admitted based on the score, on budget places, on tuition fee places or on places financed by the University (international cotutoring) depending on the availability of the places offered by the PhD supervisor.
- (4) The classification of candidates who have obtained equal marks shall be in descending order of the relevant research score-the validated score for the second criterion of the scientific activity-publications. If there is equality also in this case, then the descending order of the grade from the interview/research project granted by the admission committee is the next element of classification.
- (5) During the period assigned for the confirmation of the positions occupied by the candidates, candidates admitted on budget places (financed by study grants) will confirm the occupation by submitting the Bachelor's (Master's) degree; the candidates who had passed the bachelor's examination in the current academic year, ended during the admission contest period, will submit a graduation certificate, in original. This certificate is replaced, at the latest by the date of the end of its validity, with the corresponding diploma.
- (6) The candidates admitted for full-time PhD studies with tuition fee will confirm the place by presenting at the Doctoral School, during the period assigned for confirmation, the receipt that proves the payment of at least the first instalment. The tuition fee is paid at the Cashier of the University of Medicine and Pharmacy Tîrgu Mureş.
- (7) The candidates for full-time PhD studies admitted on state budget places, who do not submit the enrollement papers, during the first two weeks, lose the right to enrollement, and the budget places can be allocated to students who have confirmed the tuitions fee places, in a descending order of the averages obtained in the admission competition (according to Annnex 9)

8.2.4.

(1) The classification of candidates is done by evaluating the following quantifiable elements that will generate the final overall average:

- the mark given for the interview/research project, 30%;
- the average calculated for the 1st Criterion, 30%;
- the score for the 2nd Criterion, 40%.
- (a) The interview/research project is marked from 1 to 10 (integer values) with the minimum admissible mark being 5 for the calculation of the final average (Annex 08). If a PhD supervisor is also a member of the Admission Committee nominated by the CSD, the marks given as a member of the Admission Committee are the arithmetic averages (rounded to whole) of grades given by the other members of the Admission Committee. The interview is given in front of an Admission Committee, which consists of the PhD supervisor, who offered the place for admission, and the representatives of C.S.D. from I.O.S.U.D. of U.M.F. Tirgu Mures. Candidates compete, on budget tuition fee places in accordance with the topic of the project submitted, only for the available place announced by the respective PhD supervisor and its field of competence - Medicine, Dentistry or Pharmacy. If the score difference awarded by the members of the Admission Committee is greater than 2 points, the extreme marks will be eliminated.
- (b) The 1st criterion is the average of the study years and the bachelor's examination, averahe validated by the Admission Committee for PhD studies, in accordance with the diplomas and the transcripts of academic records attached to the file by the candidate. For the 1st criterion the average grade of the study years it is calculated with the average of the bachelor/dissertation exam (Annex 07).
- (c) The 2nd Criterion is the scientific activity published by the candidate in the field chosen for PhD studies. scientific books, articles in extenso, etc. For the 2nd Criterion, candidates are ranked according to the score obtained and validated by the Admission Committee, based on the grid established by this admission methodology. There will be a maximum of 2 articles published in the same magazine (indexed ISI/BDI/B +/B) except for ISI articles from the red area. Articles in press are not accepted. The Classification in the order of the score obtained and validated from 2nd Criterion is considered as the first tie-breaker element in case of candidates with equal final overall averages. (Annex 07).
- (d) Graduates of the Doctoral School Master program receive a 15% bonus for the final general average but within the overall average of 10.
- (e) In accordance with the internal regulations for demonstrators (UMFTGM-REG-19 art. 12), for the didactic activities conducted by the intern, the candidate for admission to PhD studies will receive a bonus of 10% of the score obtained for the final calculation of the general average, within the maximum limit of the average of 10, provided that these activities, recognized and certified by a certificate, have been of minimum 3 years.
- (2) The final general average calculation method is as follows:

1 ex officio p + 0.3-9-(Average 1st criterion)/10 + 0.4-9-(Grade 2nd Criterion)/10 + 0.3-9-(Interview)/10 = 10 points

Bonuses will apply only to the score of the three essential items, excluding the ex-officio point, but maximum within the final overall average of 10.

(3) The overall minimum final average for a candidate to be declared admitted is 7.00, taking into account that the scoring system is between 1 and 10 and the overall final average is calculated with two decimals without rounding.

(4) The Admission Committee completes and submits the Assessment Report (Annex 08) to CSD, which, based on the established selection criteria, draws up the classification of the candidates in order of the averages obtained, so that they occupy the places with or without tuition fee with, separately on the specific domains (Medicine, Dentistry and Pharmacy) and proposes their enrollment.

- (5) The complaints regarding the score given and validated by the Committee are filed within 24 hours (one working day) after the final results are displayed. No complaints are allowed for the interview. The complaint is resolved within 48 hours by C.S.D., and the decision taken is final.
- **8.2.5.** For the registration in the first year of PhD studies, the candidates who have confirmed the place will:
- (1) Complete the study contract in 3 copies and will submit it to the Doctoral School, signed by hand by them, by the PhD supervisor and the legal representative of IOSUD, within the first two weeks of the academic year. In the contract, there will also be mentioned the members of the doctoral guidance commission which will be established in agreement with the PhD supervisor. Thus, in order to conduct their PhD studies, the PhD candidates are assisted by a guidance commission consisting of three other members who can be part of the PhD supervisor's department, or other academics affiliated or non affiliated to the Doctoral School.
- (2) Establish, together with the PhD supervisor, the plan of the PhD studies in 3 copies, signed by hand, using the curricula of the Doctoral School for that academic year, which will be posted on the website of the Doctoral School http://www.umftgm.ro/doctorat/admitere-la-doctorat.html.
- (3) The Plan of PhD studies is submitted to the Doctoral School headquarters (UMF Tirgu Mures central building, second floor, room 236) within 15 days from PhD candidate's registration and it is approved by the Directors of C.S.D and C.S.U.D.

8.3. Transitional and final dispositions

After completing the admission procedure and signing the PhD studies contract, the admitted person has the status of PhD student during the course of the program.
