Neurologist, psychiatrist

- 1981-83, visiting scientist in the Max-Planck Institute for Neurological Research in Cologne
- 1986-87, visiting scientist, in Kure City, Japan
- 1991, visiting scientist, half year in Toulouse (INSERM, France).
- since 1992 professor of the Department of Neurology at the University of Debrecen, Hungary. Between 1992 and 2017 director of the Department of Neurology.
- His comprehensive stroke center has performed more than 1300 iv. lysis on acute stroke patients and became an international clinical, educational and research center in the eastern part of Europe. More than 10 Hungarian and other physicians from Germany, Netherlands, Israel, Rumania, Ukraine worked here and received PhD on stroke topics (clinicopathological comparisons, neurosonological studies on stroke and stroke-risk patients).
- His department hosted two times the Stroke Summer Course of the European Stroke Organisation.
- He is the founder of Hungarian Neurosonological Society, honorary member of Austrian Stroke Society and previous president of the Hungarian Stroke Society, his mandate as chair of board of directors (Eur. Stroke Org.) run out in 2016.
- visiting professor of Belgrade and Novi Sad Universities (Serbia), Cluj, Targu Mures (Rumania), Israel Association of Neurology and honorary member of Austrian Stroke Society. Corresp. member of Deutsche Gesellschaft für Klinische Neurophysiologie und Funktionelle Bildgebung
- Editorial board member: "Neurosonology (Japan)" "Clinical Neurosciences" and associate editor of "Frontiers in Stroke", "Neurosonology and Cerebral Hemodynamics" „Emergency Medicine Search and Rescue Journal” „Eur J Stroke”
- Between 2009 and 2013, he was the president of European Society of Neurosonology and Cerebral Hemodynamics.
- Between 2005-2010, as chair of European Cooperation Committee of the European Federation of Neurological Societies he introduced the regional teaching course system of EFNS in middle and eastern European countries.
- He was awarded with the prize of European Stroke Conference, Eur. Neuroson. Soc. Cer. Hemodyn, Szentgyörgyi, Batthyány-Strattmann Prize (Ministry of Health), Francis Crick Award, and Lazarevics prize (Serbian Neurol Soc) for his activity in stroke care, education and research. The President of Hungarian Republic awarded him the Knight's Cross of Republic (for outstanding educational and clinical work in the field of stroke).
- In 2016 he was elected to the corresponding member of Hungarian Academy of Sciences.
- In 2020, he received the Széchenyi prize, given by the President of Hungarian Republic, in recognition of an outstanding contribution to academic life in Hungary.
- In 2022, he was elected to the full member of Hungarian Academy of Sciences.
- At present (2023) he is the president of the Hungarian Neurological Society.
