



COMPETITION ANNOUNCEMENT FOR THE DEMONSTRATIVE - PREPARERS

PATHOPHYSIOLOGY DEPARTMENT

Academic year 2025 - 2026

Based on the Regulation on demonstrative - preparers and internals activity – UMFST REG 19, the Pathophysiology Department organizes a competition for the position of demonstrative - preparers within the Faculty of Medicine and the Faculty of Medicine in English.

Contest admission criteria:

- The candidate must be at least a 4th-year student in the Medicine program.
- The candidate must have passed all courses in the previous academic year and must have successfully completed the Pathophysiology examinations during the regular sessions.
- The candidate must have obtained a general average grade of at least 8.00 in the previous academic year.
- The candidate must not have any disciplinary sanctions.

Competition positions:

- Faculty of Medicine – 4 positions.
- Faculty of Medicine in English – 1 position.

Competition calendar:

- 13.10.2025 – Application review and transmission of interview invitations
- 14.10.2025 – Interview and publication of results
- 15.10.2025 – Submission of appeals (until 12:00) via email at fiziopatologie@umfst.ro and publication of final results.

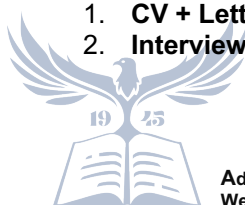
Documents required for registration:

- CV in Europass format + Memoir of scientific activity
- Letter of intent.

The documents must be submitted in PDF format to fiziopatologie@umfst.ro by October 10, 2025, at 23:59.

Competition Stages:

1. **CV + Letter of Intent** – 40% of the score
2. **Interview** – 60% of the score





Scoring – Teaching Assistant–Demonstrator Competition
Discipline of Pathophysiology – Faculty of Medicine

Test 1: CV + Motivation Letter – 40% of the final grade

Score 1

- Criterion 1 – Scientific activity – 0, 1, or 2 points
- Criterion 2 – Volunteering activity – 0, 1, or 2 points
- Criterion 3 – Motivation letter – 0, 1, or 2 points

Note: For Score 1, only the information contained in the documents submitted for the competition will be considered valid.

- Maximum Score 1 = 6 points
- Score 1 = (Criterion 1 + Criterion 2 + Criterion 3) × 10 / 6

Score 2

General arithmetic average of the 2nd and 3rd year of study.

Grade for Test 1 = (Score 1 + Score 2) / 2

Test 2: Interview – 60% of the final grade

Final Grade = Grade for Test 1 × 0.4 + Grade for Test 2 × 0.6
