



## Syllabus for the module "Medical Practice" (2nd year of study)

1.	Filling in of the primary medical records, under the strict supervision	
	and directives of a physician: patient chart/patient personal file, reference	20 hours

2.	Acquiring basic nursing techniques: measuring the temperature, pulse,	20 hours

3.	The collection of biological samples for analysis: blood, urine, sputum.	10 hours
4.	Drugs administration:	
	- oral (under supervision)	20 hours
	- intramuscular injection (just observation)	
	- intravenous injections (just observation)	
	- subcutaneous injections (just observation)	
5.	Assisting the patient during some functional explorations (Cardiology	10 hours
	Department: EKG, ecocardiography, effort tests, Holter ECG monitoring)	
6.	Basic first aid in case of emergency; assistance of patients with acute	20 hours
	respiratory failure (which does not require intubation)	
7.	Preoperative preparation of the patient	10 hours
8.	Post-operative care of patients; pain relief, diuresis monitoring,	10 hours
	gastrointestinal function monitoring;	
9.	Care/nursing of immobilized patients - prevention of injuries coused	10 hours
10	by decubitus (eschar)	40 h
10.	Monitoring of wound healing	10 hours
11.	Care/nursing of patients with colostomy, gastrostomy, jejunostomy	10 hours
12.	Composition of specific diets for some frequent pathologyies of adults	
	or infants and children (diabetes melitus, high blood presure, malabsorption	10 hours
	syndromes, gastritis/digestive ulcers, renal failure etc.)	

## **ASSESSMENT**
