



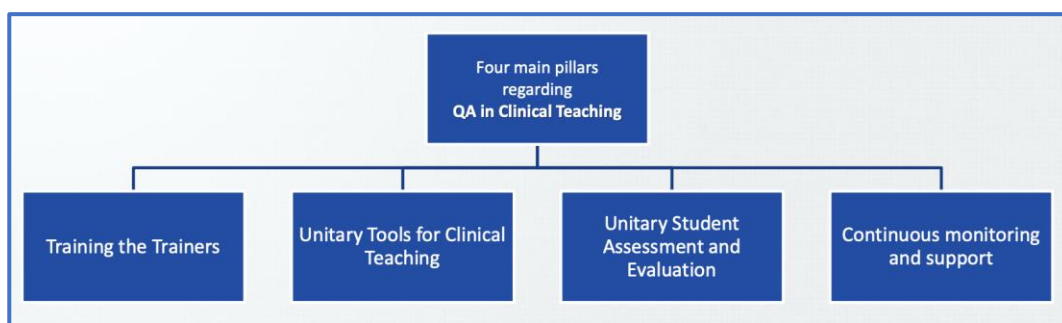
QUALITY MANAGEMENT in CLINICAL TEACHING

Academic year 2025-2026

Main target - unitary approach for all stages of the development of clinical teaching in all UMFST teaching hospitals, despite their location (Germany, Spain, Malta and Italy)

Responsible for the implementation of QUALITY CONTROL IN CLINICAL TEACHING MANAGEMENT:

- UMFST Quality Assurance Department (coordinator - Deputy Director Dr. Cosmin Bănceu)
- UMFST-UMCH Administration
- UMFST-UMCH Academic Training Center (coordinator – Assoc. Prof. Andreea Varga)
- Representatives of each UMFST Teaching Hospital



1. Training for Trainers:

- courses regarding organization of the clinical teaching and teaching methods:
 - on-site (in UMFST-UMCH partner hospitals): with all doctors involved in clinical teaching for the 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th year of study students (June-November 2025)
Target: minimum 1 course/academic year/in UMFST-UMCH partner hospital, after starting the clinical teaching, as a support for the continuous medical education.
- main themes of the training in Medical Education, organized by UMFST-UMCH:
 - *UMFST-UMCH – an innovative international concept* (organization, curriculum, teaching methods)
 - *Clinical teaching in UMFST-UMCH* – general description of clinical modules, clinical rotations
 - *Syllabus and Student Logbook* – basic tools for clinical teaching



- *Oral Case Presentation* in clinical teaching
- *Problem Based Learning* –practical approach
- *Case Based Learning & Must Seen Clinical Situations List* – practical approach
- *Assessment in clinical training for UMFST-UMCH students* – *MCQs & OSCE* (Multiple Choices Questions & Objective Structured Clinical Exam)

2. Unitary tools for clinical teaching:

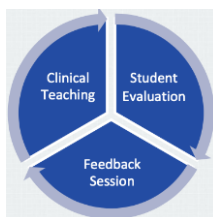
- unitary bibliography for teachers:
 - international books (free access to UMFST-UMCH digital library)
 - course-notes elaborated by UMFST teachers (books, pptx.)
 - student's logbook
- syllabus of every subject
- a variety of „scenario” for the organization of clinical teaching hours, elaborated by UMFST-UMCH teachers

3. Unitary students assessment and evaluation

- assessment of students in clinical subjects includes:
 - minimum standard for admission in the exam/each clinical subject:
 - full attendance at clinical teaching (including max. 20% absences due to medical reasons, sustained by medical reports)
 - full completion of *Student Logbook*, under supervision of teachers from UMFST-UMCH partner hospitals

Components of the final grade/subject:

- *written exam* (MCQs exam): on-site in Hamburg campus - UMCH (60% from final grade)
- *practical evaluation of clinical skills*:
 - on-going evaluation during bedside teaching is done by teachers from partners hospitals (max 10% from final grade)
 - practical exam: on-site in Hamburg campus – UMCH, as O.S.C.E (30% from final grade)
- semestrial evaluation of clinical teaching activity/each clinical subject:
 - made by students (using unitary on-line questionnaires in *Solaris* platform, managed by UMFST and on Canvas – managed by UMFST-UMCH) – 2 feedback sessions/academic year, after each exam session
 - made by students – using *Student Logbook*
 - UMFST Department for Quality Assurance will elaborate the statistical analysis of all results of students' exams and will inform stakeholders from partners hospitals about the result, about the result of *Students evaluation according* together with the plan of improvement (if is necessary).

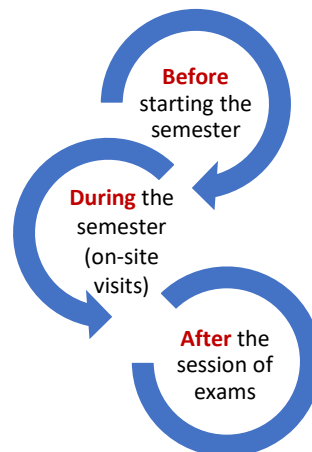




4. Continuous monitoring and support of clinical teaching for UMFST-UMCH partner hospitals

The feedback sessions with UMFST-UMCH teaching hospitals will follow the "3 steps approach":

- discussions before starting the clinical training
- on-site visits during the clinical training, in order to support the local trainers and to adapt the clinical teaching to local conditions (minimum 1 on-site visit/hospital/academic year)
- feedback sessions after each exam session



In 2026 UMFST will organize in Hamburg the 5th edition of the event called "UMFST-UMCH Hospital Days", that will include workshops focused on clinical teaching. All partners hospitals will be invited to find updates in teaching and assessment, to share their experience in teaching to UMFST-UMCH students, and to present proposals for research themes for students or elective lectures.
