



Syllabus for the module “Medical Practice” (3rd year of study)

No.	Content of the theme	No. of hours/theme
1.	Treatment of wounds - disinfection, suturing, dressing	10 hours
2.	Subcutaneous, intramuscular, intravenous injection	20 hours
3.	Vein cannulation, central catheter assembling, central venous pressure monitoring	10 hours
4.	Mounting the gastric suction probe	10 hours
5.	Urinary catheter in men and women	10 hours
6.	Blood transfusion	10 hours
7.	Hydro-electrolytic rebalancing of the surgical patient	10 hours
8.	Preparing surgery: handwashing, coating, preparation of surgery hall	10 hours
9.	Continuously monitoring the status of the patients, daily filling in the observation chart with temperature and other data determined by the doctor, and informing the doctor about any changes in patients' evolution	30 hours
10.	Sampling of biological products for routine analysis, specified by the physician and filling in the observation chart with the results of the investigations	30 hours
11.	Providing and being responsible of implementation for all hygiene and epidemiological measures, according to the indication.	10 hours

ASSESSMENT:

In the first week of September, students should submit to the UMCH Secretary Office a *Logbook* with the description of all medical activities performed in the hospitals, every day.
All activities, according with the syllabus, should be validated by the supervisor from the Hospital, with stamp and signature.

The tutor will analyze all submitted documents and will offer grades from 1 to 10.
Students will pass this subject and will receive 2 ECTS if the grade is minimum 5.
