SELECTION COMPETITION FOR ERASMUS+ TRAINEESHIP MOBILITIES FOR STUDENTS ACADEMIC YEAR 2025-2026

The Erasmus+ Office of the International Relations Department organizes the selection competition for student Erasmus+ traineeship mobilities (SMP), for the academic year 2025-2026.

These mobilities can be accessed by **students enrolled in a bachelor's degree program** at:

- Faculty of Medicine, Faculty of Medicine in English (including UMCH), Faculty of Dental Studies, and Architecture in their 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th year of study
- Faculty of Pharmacy in their 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th year of study
- All 3 or 4 years Bachelor programs, from all the Faculties, excepting the students in last year of study

Details

The Erasmus+ traineeship mobility can be carried out in almost any public or private organization located in the **countries participating in the Erasmus+ programme (see below)**, and relevant to their field of study, such as: universities, teaching or private hospitals, private practices, laboratories, research institutes, pharmacies, private or public companies, non-governmental organizations (NGOs), public authorities, EU institutions (e.g. the European Commission, European Parliament) etc.

The eligible countries for Erasmus+ placement mobilities are: EU countries, Turkey, Switzerland, Faeroe Islands, Great Britain, Andorra, Monaco, San Marino, Macedonia, Serbia.

The selected students will receive funding only if they obtain a *letter of acceptance* from the host institution, signed by the head of the concerned department.

The duration of the mobility is of 2 months and can ONLY take place after the last examination session of the academic year 2025-2026 and before the start of the academic next year 2026-2027. Students who have failed exams in the current academic year can begin their mobility only once the re-examinations session is over.

Mobility periods beyond the beginning of the next academic year (2026-2027) are not accepted.

Eligibility criteria:

Students enrolled in a bachelor program at George Emil Palade University of Medicine, Pharmacy,
 Science, and Technology of Târgu Mureș

Selection criteria:

- FULL CREDITED STUDENTS IN THE COMPLETED YEARS OF STUDY
- Academic performance: arithmetic average of completed years of study (average X 10)
