SELECTION COMPETITION
FOR ERASMUS+ STUDY MOBILITIES FOR STUDENTS IN THE FIELD OF HEALTH SCIENCES
FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-2027

The Erasmus+ Office within the International Relations Department organizes the selection competition for Erasmus+ Study Mobility for Students (SMS) for the academic year 2026-2027.

These mobilities can be accessed by

1. Students enrolled in a Bachelor 's degree study program at the :

- **Faculty of Medicine in the 3rd and 4th years of study**
- **General Medical Assistance /Nursing in the 1st and 2nd years of study**
- **Hydrotherapy, Kinesiology and Medical Rehabilitation in the 1st year of study**
- **The Faculty of Medicine in English in the 3rd and 4th years of study**
- **Faculty of Dental Medicine and Dental Medicine in English in the 3rd and 4th years of study**
- **Faculty of Pharmacy in the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th years of study; students enrolled in the 5th year of study can benefit from the mobility only in the 1st semester of the 5th year.**
- **Nutrition and Dietetics in the 1st year of study**
- **Medical Cosmetics and Cosmetic Product Technology in the 1st year of study**
- **Medicinal Chemistry in the 1st year of study**

Details

- **The duration of the study mobility** is of approximately 5 months per semester
- The mobility can only take place at a **partner university** with which G.E.Palade UMPHST Târgu Mureș has signed a **bilateral agreement**.

Financial grants

- All participants will receive a grant for living expenses of either **674 or 606 euros per month**, depending on the host country.
- All participants will receive a **travel grant** based on the distance band, calculated according to the EU Commission distance calculator.

Top-up grants





- **Top-up for Green travel** – participants who travel to the host institution by a green means of transport (carpooling, bus, train) will receive an additional amount, depending on the distance band calculated using the EU Commission distance calculator, based on travel documents.
- **Top-up for fewer opportunities** - participants who qualify for the fewer opportunities top-up will receive a supplementary amount of **250 euros per month**. For more details, please check the **FEWER OPPORTUNITIES** link.

Applications

- Applications must be submitted between **25.02.2026 and 09.03.2026, by 2:00 PM, through the Mobility Online Platform, using the following link:**

Eligibility criteria

- Students enrolled at George Emil Palade University of Medicine, Pharmacy, Science, and Technology of Târgu Mureș in the aforementioned years of study

Selection criteria

- **FULL CREDIT STUDENTS IN COMPLETED YEARS OF STUDY**
- **Academic performance:** average (arithmetic mean) of completed years of study (average X 10)
- **Scientific performance:**
 - number of abstracts published in journals as first author (n X 3);
 - number of abstracts published in journals as co-author (max. 3 abstracts, meaning max. 3 X 1 = 3 points).

For each abstract, **only one** contributor will be considered the first author.

Please note! At the time of submitting your application, you have to enter only **the average** of the completed years of study and the **number** of abstracts for each category, if applicable. **All necessary calculations for the final score will be made automatically by the Mobility Online platform.**

Only documented scientific performance, as outlined below, will be considered. For each abstract, you have to provide:

- the cover of the journal or abstract volume;
- the page containing the name, period and location of the scientific event;





- the page(s) containing the abstract as it is published in the journal.

Abstracts that do not meet these requirements or diplomas of participation without the abstract will not be taken into consideration.

Exceptionally, for the Marisiensis and TDK 2026 scientific events, **and ONLY for these events, a certificate issued and signed by the legal representatives of the student leagues of the university will be accepted, together with the abstract of the paper.*

- **Status of tutor/Demonstrator.** This must be supported by a certificate issued by the Dean's Office and signed by the head of the relevant department.

Only tutor/demonstrator activities carried out prior to the selection call (at least during the previous semester) will be taken into consideration. The total score will be increased by 10% according to the university's internal regulations.

Selection file

The selection file must contain the following documents **only in a PDF** format, with a size **no larger than 5 MB**:

- Cover letter (Motivation letter)
- Europass CV (PDF format)
- Identity card (PDF format)
- Evidence of scientific performance. These will be uploaded as **a single document** for each criterion (first author, co-author), containing all the evidence for that criterion in PDF format.
- Certificate of tutor/demonstrator status, issued by the Dean's Office and signed by the head of the relevant department.

Application

The application should be completed on the **Mobility Online Platform**, which is the dedicated platform for managing all Erasmus+ activities. On the International Relations - Erasmus website, you will find tutorials on how to use the platform at any stage of your mobility (application, during the mobility, after the mobility, etc.). **Before submitting your application, please read the instructions very carefully and follow them exactly.**
