



**ANNOUNCEMENT  
SELECTION COMPETITION  
FOR ERASMUS+ STUDY MOBILITIES FOR STUDENTS  
IN THE FIELDS OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY  
ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-2027**

The Erasmus+ Office within the International Relations Department organizes the selection competition for Erasmus+ Study Mobilities for Students (SMS) for the academic year 2026-2027.

These mobilities can be accessed by students enrolled in a:

**1. Bachelor's study programs:**

- Faculty of Engineering and Information Technology
- "Petru Maior" Faculty of Sciences and Letters
- Faculty of Economics and Law
- Faculty of Architecture in English (2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> years of study)

Applying students can be in any year of study, **except for the final year.**

**2. Master's degree programs**

- First year of a two-year master's program, and **only for the first semester of the second year of study**

**Details**

- The duration of the study mobility is approximately 5 months per semester a
- The mobility can only take place in an EU partner university (George Emil Palade University of Medicine, Pharmacy, Science and Technology of Târgu Mureș must have a signed bilateral agreement with this university).

**Financial grants**

- All participants will receive a grant for living expenses of either 674 or 606 euros per month, depending on the host country.
- All participants will receive a travel grant based on the distance band, calculated according to the EU Comm.

**Top-up grants**

- **Top-up for Green travel** – participants who travel to the host institution by a green means of transport (carpooling, bus, train) will receive an additional amount, depending on the distance band calculated using the EU Commission distance calculator, based on travel documents.
- **Top-up for fewer opportunities** - participants who qualify for the fewer opportunities top-up will receive a supplementary amount of **250 euros per month**. For more details, please check the **FEWER OPPORTUNITIES** link.

## Applications

- Applications must be submitted between **25.02.2026 and 09.03.2026, by 2:00 PM**, through **the Mobility Online Platform**, using the following link:

## Eligibility criteria

- Students enrolled at George Emil Palade University of Medicine, Pharmacy, Science, and Technology of Târgu Mureș

## Selection criteria

The selection of candidates will be based on the following criteria:

- the average (arithmetic mean) of the previous years of study, respectively the average of the first semester for students enrolled in a Bachelor's study program in the first year.
- the average (arithmetic mean) of the Bachelor's years of study for students enrolled in the first year of a master's degree program.

The average (arithmetic mean) is calculated by dividing the sum of the results of the assessments carried out for all subjects in the previous semester/academic year, regardless of whether they were passed or not, by the total number of subjects for the year or semester in question.

These averages will be validated by the respective faculty dean's offices.

## Selection file

The selection file must contain the following documents **only** in a PDF format, with a size **no larger than 5 MB**:

- Cover letter (Motivation letter)
- Europass CV (PDF format)
- Identity card (PDF format)
- Learning Agreement Proposals (proposal for an initial study program, on the form downloaded from the platform. The proposal is to be drafted after accessing the official website(s) of the university or universities to which the application is submitted and after consulting the study subjects available abroad that can be recognized at our university. These subjects should correspond to those in the candidate's study program curriculum for the desired mobility semester. The curricula at George Emil Palade University of Medicine, Pharmacy, Science and Technology of Târgu Mureș are available on the official website of the university, in the pages dedicated to the Faculties and can be confirmed by the Dean's Office. Each university selected by the student requires a separate proposal for a learning agreement. A single document will be uploaded, which may consist of several pages depending on the number of university options.



### Application

The application should be completed on the Mobility Online Platform, which is the dedicated platform for managing all Erasmus+ activities. On the International Relations - Erasmus website, you will find tutorials on how to use the platform at any stage of your mobility (application, during the mobility, after the mobility, etc.). **Before submitting your application, please read the instructions very carefully and follow them exactly.**

Please note that errors may occur while using the platform. Submitted applications will be evaluated online by a designated commission.
